Jerry Anthony is an Associate Professor at the School of Urban and Regional Planning at the University of Iowa. He teaches and researches in the areas of land use, growth management, housing and international planning. His article, “The effect of Florida’s Growth Management Act on housing affordability,” was named one of most outstanding articles published in the *Journal of the American Planning Association* in 20 years. He has received the “Excellence in Planning Education” award from the Iowa chapter of the American Planning Association—one of only two educators in Iowa to be given this award since 2000. In 2003, he co-founded a non-profit agency, [Housing Trust Fund of Johnson County](#), to provide a new and flexible source of finance for affordable housing development in Johnson County, Iowa. From 2004 onwards, this entity has provided over \$8 million to help over 750 households (including \$1.3 million for 107 housing units from July 2018-February 2019).

HTFJC is now managed by a volunteer Board, a salaried Executive Director and additional staff.
